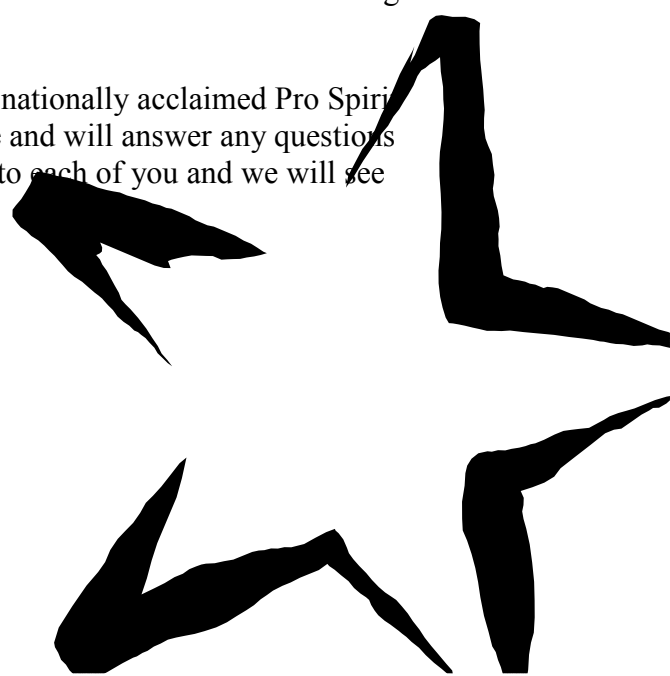

# Expectations

What am I signing up for?

**Are you willing to put in the extra time it takes to be a member of one of the BEST programs in the UNITED STATES?**

Dedication, commitment and hard work are what we are expecting our team members to bring with them to every practice. The Pro Spirit staff is the BEST. Each coach is capable of developing a champion out of each and every athlete that aspires to become a champion. We may practice everyday the week before National Championships which are scheduled for January, February, and March. This means Valentines parties, dates and dances, etc. maybe in conflict with practices. Are you willing to miss those activities?

Students may miss other important events at school or with friends and family to be a part of Pro Spirit. Extra practice schedules are given out in advance so that students/families will be aware of extra/extended practices. We try to give families time to make arrangements and/or adjust schedules to have your child at all regular and extra/extended practices.

We are very organized and we plan in advance any extras that the teams may need. But, impromptu, emergency practices may be called due to unexpected events. These practices are mandatory as well.

## How do I decide which Level I should tryout for?

We recommend that candidates review the skill requirement chart below and determine what level they have mastered. Candidates should attend the level that they have mastered. A mastered skill is defined as a skill that students can warm up and execute on their own, with out a spot or assistance. We want every candidate to feel confident when trying out. Candidates will have an opportunity to show us any skills that they have mastered and/or working on for the next level.

**Skill Requirements-**We are looking for mastered skills in each of these levels. Mastered is not the ability just to throw the skill, it is the ability to perform the skill with good form and with a certain level of perfection.

# Tryout Procedure

1. Download packet and forms. Read information thoroughly.
2. Attach \$50.00 tryout fee to a signed, registration form.
3. Attach a small head shot picture to the registration form.
4. Turn in registration forms by March 26th Include:
  - Registration Form
  - ACH direct form
  - Agreement Form
  - Birth certificate
5. Attend tryout times for your age/level.
6. Wear black shorts, black t-shirt or black sports bra, tennis shoes and hair up. Presentation is considered.
7. Relax... it will be fun! No stress allowed at our tryouts

## What to expect at our tryouts?

All students will be evaluated according to the USASF credentialing guidelines. Each student will be evaluated in long tumbling (running) and standing tumbling. On each skill they either receive a “mastered” or “not mastered” mark. We will begin with the Level 1 skills, beginner, and then continue through the elements as far as the student can. All candidates will have an opportunity to show us their best long tumbling pass, standing tumbling skills, jumps and jump combinations.

Candidates 9 years and older will learn a short 8ct dance and will perform it in a group. The dance is performed to show us their ability to move to music, sharpness in motion technique, timing and showmanship. Candidates 8 years and younger will learn the Pro Spirit cheer. We also look at strength and flexibility.

## Level 5 Tryout Information

Candidates that are interested trying out for a Level 5 team must have a parent present at the Level 5 Parent Meeting in order to participate in the tryout. The Level 5 meeting will be held Thursday April 1, 6:00-6:30pm at Pro Spirit. This meeting is to inform families of the time and financial commitment required for these teams. If you are not able to commit to the demands of a level 5 team, please do not participate in the tryout. Level 5 team members must be 100% dedicated to their team. Parent support is a must in order to be considered for this team.

# Team Development

**Building a POWERFUL MACHINE... the result is a high-performance, razor sharp, spine-tingling MACHINE called PRO SPIRIT!!**

## Team Development

The staff spends many hours, weeks, months working towards building the strongest teams possible. When each individual part (flyer, base, back spot) is thoughtfully put together the result is a high-performance, razor sharp, spine-tingling MACHINE called PRO SPIRIT. No decision is taken lightly, we want each team member to be an important contributor to their team. Self worth, accountability and confidence begin to surface when team members know that they are an important piece of the puzzle.

## Phase I - Level Placement

Pro Spirit Team members will be posted on our website on Saturday April 3rd. For security of the children, this posting will only be up for a 24 hour period. Students that are on this list have secured a spot on a team at Pro Spirit. Students will work out with their LEVEL for April and part of May. This will give students an opportunity to fine tune their individual skills, work on new skills or try to master skills that they are very close to. This also gives our coaches an opportunity to put the best mix of students together to maximize each team. It will give us time to make the absolute best placement for everyone and will minimize the possibility of having to move someone from team to team.

## Phase II - Preliminary Team Placement

The next step that PS takes when creating solid, competitive teams is a "PRELIMINARY TEAM" placement. We have to start working on team skills such as stunts, baskets and pyramids. We need to try certain combinations of kids together to create the best TEAM. The staff at Pro Spirit is dedicated to individual improvement and team success. The preliminary team placement gives the kids and coaches a chance to test individuals as a whole and it gives the kids an opportunity to prove that they can meet the expectations of their team.

The preliminary teams are a starting point, there will be movement. We need each student/parent to trust us and let us work through this preliminary phase. We do have a plan. Actually, we have Plan A, Plan B, Plan C and so on! We will be making changes all season long. Changes to team placement typically occur before we begin choreography camps, before we begin pre-season competition and before we begin national competitions. Please share this information with your child so they know and understand that they may move teams within the season. Of course we try to set solid

teams from the beginning, but movement is inevitable. Pro Spirit teams are continuously evolving, because we encourage self improvement. We know that there will be anxiety as we begin the team development process. The level of refinement that PS takes to create a

team goes far beyond any other program. Our goals are the same as yours; strong, competitive teams and continuous individual improvement.

Phase III - Actual TEAM placement will be determined before team camps begin in August. We want to choreograph routines with team members that can offer the skills for their particular level.

At the top of the “level” – Pro Spirits goal is to “max out” the score sheet. Students must have competition ready skills before moving to the next level. Students may be working on new skills, but we will not place a student on a team that does not have the skill mastered.

Phase IV- Revisions to team placement after preseason are usually minimal and athletes are informed individually if movement deems necessary.

**The level of refinement that PS takes to create a team goes far beyond any other program. Our goals are the same as yours; strong, competitive teams and continuous individual improvement.**



# Attendance Policy

Pro Spirit is successful because of our  
**MANDATORY** attendance policy.

- Excused absences include: illness with fever, vomiting and school event that earns a grade and school cheerleading.
- **Other sports or work that conflicts with Pro Spirit practices are NOT excused. If a conflict with an outside sport arises, cheerleaders must choose before the season begins.**
- Absences must be reported to the head coach via email one week before the absence occurs. Just because you email your absences, this does not necessarily excuse the absence.
- Absolutely NO misses during the months of January, February and early March. This is our national season and we will be training extra during these months. Cheerleaders that miss during these months will not participate at their national competitions.
- Summer Attendance- NEW THIS SEASON- Summer attendance is VERY important to the development of the team. Please note that we expect team members to be at the majority of the summer practices. Summer vacation forms must be submitted to your head coach in May. Practices are still a high priority during the summer, low attendance will effect team placement.
- The staff has family and outside lives also. We too want time from the gym. If extra practices are scheduled, they are for the benefit of the team and a coach deems it necessary for that team's confidence level and success. The Pro Spirit staff is committed to your kids! They are willing to go the extra mile for them. 100% attendance at extra practices is a must. Please do not waste your coach's/teammate's time by not attending extra practices.

## **Attendance Policy**

- All practice session are mandatory.
- Members must be on time to practice. Continual tardiness will be grounds for disciplinary action or dismissal.
- If an absence must occur, an absence request must be emailed to the head coach and cc. Jeff or Diana one week in advance.
- Two unexcused absences will warrant disciplinary action, a third will be grounds for dismissal.
- Continuous failure to be productive at practice is grounds for disciplinary action or dismissal.
- If you are sick or injured, you must still attend practice. You will not be required to participate. You will watch any changes that directly affect you.
- All competitions are mandatory.

# Unique only to Pro Spirit

## Special programs and events set Pro Spirit apart from other all star gyms.

Pro Spirit goes above and beyond the normal expectation of a cheer gym.

We offer many unique programs and events that students may have an opportunity to experience as a team member.

Here is a small look as some of the special programs and events that make Pro Spirit one of the nation's best.

- **Special Stars-** Pro Spirit is proud to offer a team experience to kids and adults with special needs. Our Special Stars practice once a week under the direction of Jeff Miller.
- **Jr. Staff Program-** The Jr. Staff program is a work program offered to team members at Pro Spirit. Members must apply for this job directly after tryouts. "Jr. Staffers" are selected on their leadership skills, ability to spot and teach, availability, years at the gym, dedication. These team members work with our younger teams. They learn how to coach and work with students. The Jr. Staff program is a work-trade program.
- **LEADERSHIP-** The LEADERSHIP program has just completed its second year in existence and the program is really beginning to gain momentum! Diana wanted to ensure that the traditions, values, expectations along with the level of loyalty was being modeled and passed on to new team members each year. Thus, LEADERSHIP was created. Team members must be a "Legacy" member to apply. (5 years plus at PS). Members are interviewed and evaluated by the adult staff at Pro Spirit from our owners, coaching staff, to our office staff and Booster Club Executive Board. Students are evaluated on attendance, attitude, work ethic, "team player", parent support, respect, etc. The LEADERSHIP team meets approximately 4 times through out the season. A retreat, lock in and meetings give Diana an opportunity to help members develop leadership qualities that can be passed on to their team and be used for a lifetime.
- **PS Show Off-** The entire competitive program puts on a Show for family and friends in the month of January. It is the perfect time for the teams to have a dress rehearsal before the national competitions begin. Parents, friends, neighbors, teachers are all welcome. This is our in house Pep Rally to get everyone fired up and ready for nationals.

# Unique only to Pro Spirit

- Recognition Rally- After each competition, team members and their parents meet directly after awards and we have our own awards. Coaches will address the team and review the days' performance and out come. Teams are rewarded with trinkets and goodies to represent placement of the event. Individual recognition is also awarded, for example: "Star Performer", "Key", "You make a Difference", "Team Player" and so on. We feel that it is important to have immediate closure of the event. Any important news can be shared at that time too.
- Awards Banquet- At the end of each season, we have an awards banquet to recognize EVERYONE! Cheerleaders, coaches, booster club board, team reps, office staff, parents...it take EVERYONE to have a successful year. This is a celebration of the year's events that includes all team members and their families. The banquet is different every year. We have had BBQ's, formal banquets; we even had a party on the Dallas Cowboys football field. Because we have very little turn over in team membership from year to year, we have kids that have been team members for 5, 6, 7...10 years! We like to mix it up from year to year. Special senior recognition, Rookie of the Year, Team of the Year, scholarships, Queen and Princess of the gym to name a few are unique awards that are presented at the banquet.
- Gym wide Service Project- Each year PS gets involved with the community or even globally to reach out to others that need help. We are not just training cheerleaders, but we are training LEADERS. We feel that teaching kids to reach out to others and see beyond themselves is so important. In past seasons, Pro Spirit has "adopted" soldiers globally, sent care packages, letters and pictures to service men and women around the world. This was an AMAZING experience for our gym. This past year we dedicated our efforts to help find a cure for cancer. We participated in the Race for the Cure, we raised \$30,000 for the Susan G. Komen Foundation as a team of 13 coaches and parents walked in The 3 Day, over 50 students grew out their hair all season so that they could cut 8 inches to support the Pantene Beautiful Lengths project, an organization that makes wigs for cancer patients.
- Pro Spirit All star Booster Club-(PSASBC) Our Booster Club is an intricate part of our program. We are a state registered booster club. We appoint an Executive Board and Team Reps that support our team members. Team reps are the liaison between team coach and parents and are the key communicator for the team. The booster club helps organize parties, the Show Off, awards banquet and other activities for the kids.

# Financial Information

## 2010-2011

Tuition and Competition Fees- EVERY DOLLAR that you pay at Pro Spirit is accounted for and is paid out on behalf of your child. We know that competitive cheerleading is expensive! Pro Spirit does not “add” or “pad” these fees to support our coaches for travel, etc. We are constantly working towards an affordable, more efficient payment system to help our customers balance out the cost of this awesome sport. We are committed to offering the most affordable, yet highest quality program possible.

- Please fill out the ACH electronic payment form and turn in with your tryout registration
- All changes to your ACH account including amounts, adds, drops, account numbers, etc must be submitted in writing using our ACH change form in order to activate your request.
- Changes can take up to 30 days.
- All tuition and competition fee payments will be electronically processed.
- Tuition will be electronically drafted on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.
- Tuition will not be altered throughout the season for holiday closures or added practices. Team students receive many extra hours during competition season to compensate for gym closures.
- **If you choose to tryout after April, a percentage of past tuition will be assessed for prior months.**
- Competition Fees-We do not have the exact competition registration fees for each event at this time. Last year team members paid approximately \$750 in competition fees. **Pro Spirit will be drafting an additional \$100 per month towards competition fees beginning June 1<sup>st</sup>.** Expect your draft to include this additional \$100 for 7 months or more. Drafts will be adjusted to the appropriate competition fee totals for each team as soon as possible. Any fund raising money will be applied towards the end of the payment schedule. Any balance due after the \$700, will be collected by December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Delinquent Accounts-These fees MUST be paid for your child to participate. Accounts that are behind 2 months will be given a friendly reminder to catch up. Athletes that have accounts that become 3 months past due will no longer be able to participate.

- Merchandise, uniforms, extra classes, clinics, etc... can be paid for electronically, Visa, MC, check or cash.
- Required Practice wear- \$60- Payment due at time of pick up.
- Optional practice wear items will be available for those athletes that wish to have more than one set of practice wear or other optional items.
- Spirit Fee- \$50.00 per cheerleader will be included in your competition fee total for spirit items, shirts, goodies throughout the season for parents and cheerleaders.
- The Booster Club organizes 2-3 fund raising opportunities to help families with competition fees. Fund raising is optional.
- Custom Music - \$25
- Choreography fee – \$175 -Each team will have a crunch choreography course with Diana, Team coaches and/or guest choreographer/instructor to learn their routine.
- ALL TEAM MEMBERS are required to pay the choreography fee, whether you attend the camp or not, are added to the team later in the season, etc.
- Uniforms are not included in your monthly electronic draft. Uniforms are ordered from a company that is independent from PS. Uniforms must be paid in full at the time of the order.
- Uniforms- Pro Spirit has the BEST uniforms in the country! Our uniforms are custom made and designed by Diana for Pro Spirit. We have 2 uniform designs.

**Blue Uniform:** Tiny Stars, Blues Stars and Green Stars

We will be designing a NEW “Blue” uniform to replace the Original Blue Sparkle Uniform that we have had for 5 years.

**Black Uniform:** All other teams. This will be the same as the 2009-2010 season.

# Rules and Regulations

## Dismissal

- Grounds for Dismissal from Pro Spirit include, but are not limited to:
- No smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages or use of drugs. This will warrant immediate dismissal from the squad.
- Challenging the authority of the coach or person in charge, by competitor or parent, will be automatic dismissal from the team.
- Abusive behavior, lying, stealing or any other negative form of behavior is grounds for dismissal.
- Each member will follow all additional rules and guidelines given by the coach or person in charge.
- Any negative behavior towards a Pro Spirit member or to another gym, via any medium (i.e. internet, My Space, Facebook); will result in dismissal from team.
- No inappropriate pictures or language to be used on the internet.

## Leadership

- Each member must be aware that no person has a right to be on Pro Spirit.
- It is a privilege.
- Each member and parent must be aware of the responsibilities required and the commitment he or she is making to the team.
- Each member must be willing to cooperate with and be helpful to the coach or any person in charge.
- Each member must realize the manner in which they conduct themselves while representing Pro Spirit or not, directly reflects on the entire squad and coach.
- Each member will be willing to work hard, take directions and strive for excellence.

## Expectations

- Members will set and maintain the highest examples of behavior.
- Members will maintain the proper appearance with no extremes in apparel, hair, make-up, piercing or tattoos. Coach's decision is final.
- **MEMBERS WILL BE ON TIME TO ALL ACTIVITIES!**
- Members will do everything in their power to achieve personal and squad goals.
- Each member is responsible for finding out any missed information.
- Team members must attend all practices and must participate.

## Competitions

- Members are required to attend all competitions. This means through the awards ceremony. If parents are unable to stay for the whole competition, other arrangements must be made so that the member can stay.
- The highest standard of sportsmanship is expected from athletes and parents.
- Athletes must be prepared for competition. Uniform clean, including shoes and appearance All American.

## Safety

- Jeopardizing the safety of oneself or any other member is grounds for disciplinary action or dismissal.
- There is absolutely no gum, candy or jewelry, food or drinks (exception of water, of any type in the gym).
- All cell phones must be turned off or simply not brought into the gym.

### **Pro Spirit Parental Obligations Rules and Regulations**

- Any negative behavior towards a Pro Spirit member, Pro Spirit gym, Pro Spirit staff or to another gym, via any medium, will result in dismissal your competitor from team.
- To make sure your son or daughter is on time and attends all practices and events.
- Parents are to inform the coach if the competitor is to be late or absent form practice.
- Parents are to fulfill any financial obligations on time.
- Parents are to encourage and support Pro Spirit to be the best they can be.
- If parents are unable to stay for the whole competition, other arrangements must be made so that the member can stay for the whole competition.
- **Whoever signs the release form is financially responsible.**
- Do not question the coach's decision about the routine or practices
- Parents need to maintain manners and civility at all functions.
